Srivari Kalyanotsavam:




Srivari Kalyanotsavam is one of the most sought after Arjitha sevas (Special Puja on payment) performed to the processional deities of Lord Venkateswara and his two consorts Goddess Sridevi and Goddess Bhudevi. The Srivari Kalyanotsavam (the celestial wedding) is an arjitha seva which is performed at the sacred abode of Lord Venkateswara at Tirumala daily all through the year except on select festive occasions such as the annual Brahmotsavams, Lunar or Solar Eclipse days etc. The Srivari Kalyanotsavam is held daily between 12 noon to 1 PM. The Srivari Kalyanotsavam Programme telecast live daily on SVBC garners tremendous viewership across the country.

Time Band: 12 PM to 1 PM (Prime)

Dolotsavam is a fascinating Arjitha seva performed to the processional deities of Lord Malayappa Swamy and his two divine consorts Goddess Sridevi and Goddess Bhudevi on a daily basis. The arjitha seva is held 6 days in a week at the world renowned Tirumala temple and the proceedings are live telecast on SVBC (Except on Sundays). As part of the Dolotsavam ritual, the deities of Lord Malayappa Swamy and his two consorts are seated on a Golden Swing (Unjal) in the Aina Mahal (Addala Mandapan or Mirror hall) situated inside the Tirumala temple, and the deities are rhythmically swung to the accompaniment of the Veda Parayanam and the Mangala Vayidams.

Time Band: 1:40 PM to 2:00 PM (Prime)

Arjitha Brahmotsavam:



Arjitha Brahmotsavam is an important daily Arjitha seva performed inside the sacred abode of Lord Venkateswara at Tirumala. The 'Arjitha Brahmotsavam' is the abridged version of the Brahmotsavam event and the daily Arjitha Brahmotsavam is performed at the Vaibhavotsava mandapam where the vahanams are kept throughout the year. As part of the Arjitha Brahmotsavam ritual, Lord Malayappa Swamy is seated majestically atop the Garuda Vahanam, the Hanumantha Vahanam and the Sesha Vahanam in a sequence.

Time Band: 2:00 PM to 2:30 PM (Prime)

PROGRAMME DETAILS



Vasanthotsavam:

Vasanthotsavam is a daily arjitha seva held at the Lord Balaji temple at Tirumala wherein a celestial bath (Abhishekam) is rendered to the processional deities of Lord Malayappa Swamy and his two consorts Goddess Sridevi and Goddess Bhudevi. The Seva begins with perfumeries and scents applied to the deities amidst the chanting of the vedic hymns including the Sri Suktam, Purusha Suktam, Narayana Suktam and the Bhu Suktam. As the ritual draws to an end, a perforated plate is held on top of the deities and water poured, creating a shower and a visual feast to the devotees.

Time Band: 2:30 PM to 3:00 PM (Prime)





Sahasra Deepalankara Seva:

Sahasra Deepalankara Seva (SD Seva) is one of the most celebrated daily rituals held at the sacred abode of the Lord of the seven hills daily. As part of the Sahasra Deepalankara Seva, about 1000 Diyas (Ghee-lit lamps) are decorated in the Unjal mandapam situated at the south eastern corner of the Tirumala temple. And as the sun sets, the Lord is majestically seated on the Unjal (Swing) amidst the glowing lamps and the deities are swung rhythmically to the Vedic hymns and the Annamacharya Sankeertans. The SD Seva which is live telecast on Sri Venkateswara Bhakti Channel garners highest viewership among the daily programmes.

Time Band: 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM (Prime)

Nadaneerajanam:

Nadaneerajanam is a unique cultural phenomenon which showcases the great Indian heritage in dance and music especially its bhakthi tradition. This 90-minute programme staged everyday without a break since August 15, 2009, on a concert platform opposite to the Sri Venkateswara temple at Tirumala has been host to a daily programme of classical music and/or dance called Nada Neerajanam.

Adding tremendously to the reach and popularity of Nada Neerajanam is TTD's Sri Venkateswara Bhakti Channel (SVBC) which telecasts live everydays' programme. This telecast enjoys a viewership of millions across India and is seen abroad too in over 100 countries including in Europe, America and other parts of the globe.






Goddess Padmavathi Ammavari Brahmotsavams, Tiruchanoor:


